1. Board Chair Bob Beville called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. via hybrid meeting (in-person/zoom) with a quorum present.
2. The minutes of the March 31, 2023 Board of Directors Meeting were approved as presented.
3. President Jeannine Joy thanked all our volunteers and those who attended the May 3rd Volunteer Appreciation breakfast at Broadway Palm Dinner Theatre. Jeannine also mentioned that she had attended one of the town hall meetings of Resilient Lee in Harlem Heights. Jeannine highly recommends attending one; very eye-opening.
4. Board Chair Bob Beville stated that we had another successful Swing into Spring in LaBelle raising a net total of \$21,872 for Hendry/Glades Counties.
5. Campaign Co-Chairs, Sally Jackson and Matt Humphreys, announced that we made, and exceeded goal, with a total of \$11.2 million. This amount does not include Hurricane Relief Funds. The Alexis de Tocqueville Dinner, hosted by David Lucas, topped it off to help reach our goal. The 199 Alexis de Tocqueville members raised \$5.79 million with 20 new members, that's 51.7% of our total campaign. The community campaigns and the employee campaigns were amazing. Special thanks to the board, campaign cabinet, community committees, campaign coordinators, and staff. This is the 30th consecutive year that our community has helped United Way reach or exceed the goal.
6. The meeting adjourned at 8:21 a.m. Next month will be our Annual Meeting of the Membership and Board Meeting, in person, on June 2, 2023.
